### **DEFINITIONS:**

A bowl must be of equal diameter and height or greater in diameter than height.

All entries must be arranged by the exhibitor at the hall under the supervision of the Stewards. Any exhibitor failing to do this or allowing any parent or friend to assist in arranging exhibits may be disqualified. Every exhibit must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor and Classes 3, 8, 9, 10, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19 must have been grown by him or her.

Arrangements must contain flowers, fruit or vegetables.

### **7 YEARS AND UNDER**

#### **Class**

1. Decorated saucer arranged in wet sand (max 16cm diameter)  
(Sand should be covered)
2. Novelty Exhibit – Made from fruit and/or vegetables  
(Flowers allowed) Must be named
